

# Learn to Sail this Summer at St. Peter's, Arichat, Dundee or Mabou

The Wallace MacAskill Yacht Club is pleased to offer the Nova Scotia Yachting Association Mobile Sailing Program for 2009. Our goal is to make it easy for people of all ages and abilities to get on the water in small boats. Our mobile fleet includes 4 brand new Optimist dinghies, and we'll be taking them on the road for 1 week programs at Arichat, Dundee and Mabou this summer. In addition, we will be hosting our usual sailing school at the St. Peter's Lions Marina for 3 weeks this summer.

We teach you how to handle a small sailboat safely and confidently, with programs for absolute beginners and for those who want to hone existing skills and add to their sailing experiences.

Our CYA certified Instructor is Justin Stanley, a student from nearby Cap la Ronde, Isle Madame. Volunteer Sailing School Directors are senior club members Barry MacNeil and Jeff Stanley, supported by the membership of the Wallace MacAskill Yacht Club, St. Peter's ([www.wallacemacaskillyachtclub.com](http://www.wallacemacaskillyachtclub.com)).

## Programs

White Sail Programs 1, 2 & 3 are offered in all weeks, at all locations. Our Disability program, Adult program and our Bronze 4 programs are offered at St. Peter's location only.

### White Sail 1, 2 & 3

These introductory sailing programs developed by the Canadian Yachting Association cover safety, seamanship and boat handling in winds up to 9 knots. Students enroll by the week and can proceed at their own pace with personalized instruction from our Level 1 CYA certified instructor. ### Bronze Level 4

This program introduces advanced sailing techniques, including sail trim, boat tuning, boat maintenance, trapezing and spinnaker use. After completion of Bronze standards, sailors are competent in winds up to 25 km/hr.

### Disability Sailing

Sailing lessons for disabled sailors are customized on an individual basis, following a personal consultation with the sailing instructor. No fees are charged for participants in this program.

### Adult Learn-to-Sail

Held on weekday evenings, or by special arrangements pending availability of instructor and boats. This program offers the White Sail Levels 1, 2 & 3, and/or customized instruction to meet individual needs. Offered Mon. - Fri. 6:30 pm - 8:30 pm.

## Sailing School Fees

Scholarships available for qualified youth. Please enquire. There are no fees charged to students in our Disability program.

### Youth instruction (ages 8 - 18)

White Sail 1 \$ 65/week (normally takes 1 week)  
White Sail 2 & 3 \$ 95/week (normally each takes 2 weeks)  
Bronze 4 \$ 250 for 2 week program

### Adult Learn-to-Sail

All programs \$ 120/week

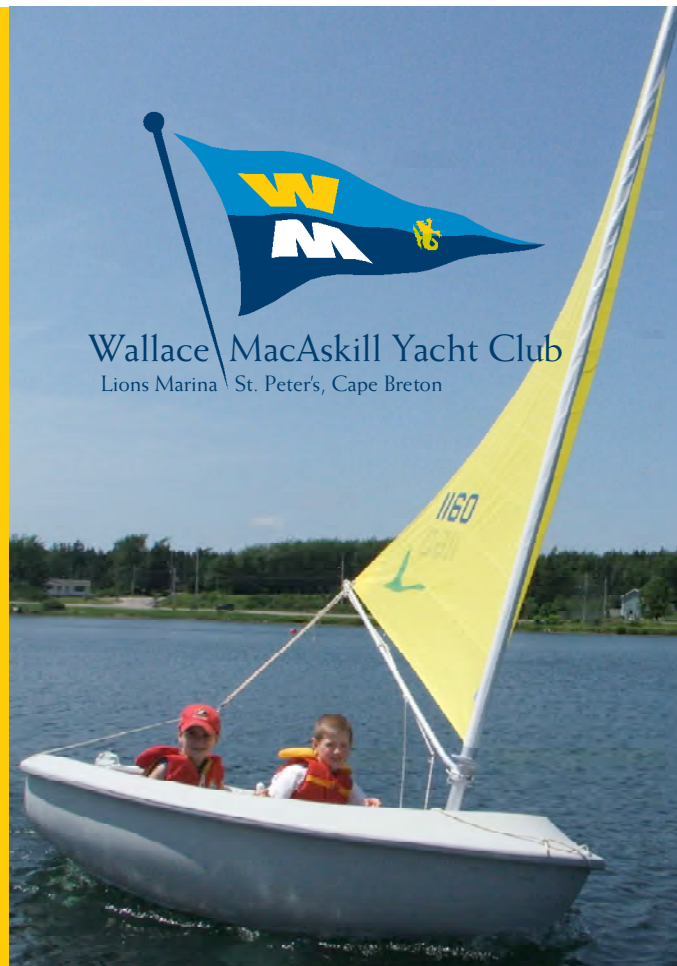
