



2024 Wednesday Night Race Series – Information Sheet



From June through September - 2024

June 19, 2024

Race dates are posted on the WMYC Race Poster at the Marina and on our website, which serves as the Notice of Race

1. **Registration** – Boats register online or at the St. Peter's Marina at the start or during the season. There is no registration fee. Boats must provide their PHRF rating documentation (or be assigned a handicap by our race committee) and insurance information in order to participate in the race.
2. **Sponsors** –St. Peter's Marina
3. **Communications** – Monitor channel 72 on your VHF for course number and further in instructions.
4. **Skipper's Meeting** – 1530 hrs. at the Marina.
5. **Race Start Time** – GMT +3 (GPS time) is the official race time. Five minute countdown to race start begins at 16:25 pm
6. **Course** – In Jackson Bay using yellow and blue club buoys, one orange buoy at the start line and navigational marks. Unless specified as a race buoy, all navigational buoys to be honoured. The courses are provided at the skipper's meetings, posted on the WMTC bulletin board.
Start and Finish Line: In Jackson Bay between Club buoy and Orange Buoy.
7. **Starting Procedure** – **NOTE: Flags are not currently used. Information is provided for reference**
 - (I) The **I**: Yellow flag with solid black circle at center,  goes up at five minutes before the start and remains up until the start. This indicates that Rule 30.1 (the around-the-ends rule) is in effect at the start. The Rules of Racing (RRS) don't kick in for another minute. **It is accompanied by a sound signal.**
 - (II) The **P** (Preparatory) flag  goes up at four (4) minutes before the start. The P flag is blue with a white, square center. **It is accompanied by a sound signal.** This flag will remain up for three minutes.
 - (III) The **P** flag comes **down** at one minute before the start. **It is accompanied by a sound signal.** The only flag still up is the **I Flag**.
 - (IV) **START:** The **I** Flag comes down. **It is accompanied by a sound signal.**

OTHER FLAGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- (V) **X:** Blue cross on a white background . It means that one or more boats have started prematurely. The race committee may, but is not obligated to, inform the guilty boat(s). This flag will be lowered when all premature boats have returned or after 4 minutes, whichever comes first.
- (VI) **FIRST SUBSTITUTE:**  This is a triangular flag with blue edges top and bottom and a yellow center. This flag indicates a **General Recall**. Everybody starts over. New start sequence, etc.

8. *Summary of start procedure*

Start minus 5 minutes: I flag up and horn

Start minus 4 minutes: P Flag up and horn

Start minus 1 minute: P Flag down and horn

Start (0 minutes): I flag up down and horn. X flag goes up for boats over the line.

9. **Race Finish** – The course may be shorted as the discretion of the race committee. The course is to be announced at the Skipper's meeting and updated on VHF Channel 72 as conditions change during the race.
10. **Scoring** – Scoring will be according to the Rules of Racing.. PHRF handicaps will be used to correct finish times.

11. *Post-Race Activities at the Marina*

WM-02 - 45 39.128N 60 50.895W (by Wambolt's Place; Rte. 4)

WM-03 - 45 39.749N 60 50.555W (Joe Norman Cove)

WM-04 - 45 39.993N 60 51.706W (North Side)
